Please frame all shots in landscape, not portrait.

Stand next to the plant, in front of it, or hold it and speak to the camera: slowly and clearly.

Suggested script:

"Hi, my name is <mark>(......)</mark>. I'm on (<mark>insert name</mark>) Country, in (<mark>insert name of suburb/state</mark>) [if you don't know the Country, just say what suburb/state you're in] and I'm taking the Botanic Gardens Seasol plant challenge to celebrate Botanic Gardens Day 2023.

I want to introduce you to a plant that inspires me, (<mark>insert name, common and/or scientific</mark> and/or indigenous). It inspires me because (<mark>insert reason(s)</mark>).

What plant inspires YOU?"

Example script:

"Hi, my name is Alex. I'm on Wajuk Country in Perth, WA, and I'm taking the Botanic Gardens Seasol plant challenge to celebrate Botanic Gardens Day 2023.

I want to introduce you to a plant that inspires me, Kingia australis or bullanock. It looks a bit like a grass tree and can live for hundreds of years. It's from the Kwongan ecoregion of southwestern Australia and is found nowhere else in Australia, or the world.

What plant inspires YOU?"
